



Re: Potential LEED v4 credits for projects using Park Avenue Tufted Nylon Cut-Pile Entrance Matting by Amarco Products

To whom it may concern:

Many finishing products have the potential to contribute points to LEED v4, however the credits can only be gained when calculating the combined performance of all the products used on a particular LEED project; therefore no single product can guarantee you will obtain LEED v4 credits.

The LEED v4 rating system promotes improved practices in the following credit categories:

- Location & Transportation
- Sustainable Sites
- Water Efficiency
- Energy & Atmosphere
- Materials & Resources
- Indoor Environmental

Amarco Products Park Avenue may contribute to the following LEED credits (points), the following is based on LEED NCv4:

- v4 MRp2: Material and Resources – Construction and demolition waste management planning:
  - The tiles or planks reduce waste from the installation process, reducing waste in landfills.
  - Made from recyclable material and / or is a reusable product, reducing waste in landfills.
- v4 MRc3: Material and Resources – Building product disclosure and optimization, sourcing of raw materials:
  - Option 2. Sourcing of raw materials.  
Recycled content. Recycled content is 10% postconsumer.
- v4 EQc1: Indoor Environmental Quality – Enhanced indoor air quality strategies:
  - Option 1. Enhanced IAQ strategies. Installed with at least 10 feet (3 meters) in length in the primary direction and maintained on a weekly basis.
- v4 EQc2: Indoor Environmental Quality – Low emitting materials:
  - Option 1. Budget Calculation Method.
